The Parish Church of St Helier, Jersey celebrates its patronal festival, or St Helier's Day on the Sunday nearest to 16 July, the day that the Saint was martyred.

Leaders of the Anglican, Roman Catholic and Methodist Churches along with civic leaders gather at the Parish Church of St Helier and walk in procession to Elizabeth Castle. From here the Constable of St Helier climbs the steep and ancient steps to the Hermitage. This little chapel was built over the niche in the rock where the Saint is said to have lived and worshipped. Here a wreath is laid.
